



## **DRIVE Program**

The First Tee DRIVE Program (Develops Rewarding Inspiring Values for Everyone) is a set of 18 golf Activity Plans designed to provide a fun, engaging program which exposes young people to the behaviors associated with The First Tee's Nine Core Values.

### Objectives

- Provide a golf program appropriate for youth serving organizations
- Develop appreciation for the positive personal and social values associated with the game
- Present golf to students as a lifelong recreation and physical fitness activity

### Curriculum Content

- Activity Guide written with the youth activity leader and volunteer leader in mind
- The program is designed to fit in a variety of settings and locations
- The curriculum includes 18 detailed activity plans, an information section explaining teaching methods, safety and class management procedures, instructional cue cards, golf terms and other helpful information for successful implementation.
- Incorporates the Nine Core Values which include: honesty, integrity, sportsmanship, respect, confidence, responsibility, perseverance, courtesy and judgment

### Training and Equipment

- Includes a one and a half hour online session
- Contains lesson design, equipment, safety, and skills instruction
- Seamlessly integrates The First Tee Nine Core Values into physical lessons
- Provides the ability to view video clips of physical educators delivering core content
- SNAG®, Starting New At Golf is developmentally appropriate golf equipment
- Set contains equipment to teach large groups of 25 to 45 students
- Set includes oversized clubs, tennis-style balls, and a variety of targets

### Cost - \$2,500 per location

- Includes one equipment set, one curriculum manual and two online trainings
- Includes eight hours of consulting by TFTSV staff
- Cost for the program is a one-time fee that will serve children for many years

### Individual Student School (ISA) Agreement

- Identify proper storage for all equipment
- Deliver program by trained and certified DRIVE leader
- Impact roughly half of the student population in year one and all students by year three
- Complete and report forms to The First Tee as needed
