The First Tee of Silicon Valley impacts the lives of young people by providing educational programs that build character, instill life-enhancing values and promote healthy choices through the game of golf. We do this through six progressive levels – PLAYer, Par, Birdie, Eagle, Ace, and Albatross. Participants learn to appreciate diversity, resolve conflicts, and set goals for their future.

Our program is affordable and accessible. Of the 1,000+ participants last year in our certifying programs, approximately 25% of those participants received significant financial assistance, meaning they paid \$10 for an 8-lesson season.

Our instruction, which can last up to 12 years, makes an observable impact in the lives of children. The young people we mentor behave better, get better grades, and are healthier than their peers. Our participants report good study habits and grades, with over 85% earning all A's or B's in school.

The First Tee of Silicon Valley is proud of the impact it has had on these young people and the community at large. We hope to build on this momentum and reach a total of 4,000 on-course participants by 2020. Thank you for being part of our program's success!
